


BIOX LOCATION IN CENTRAL LONDON

Biox is located in the **Technopark Building** on the campus of **London South Bank University**, near the **Elephant & Castle**, as shown by the blue arrow in the map below.



The Technopark Building has two entrances. Do not use the *Admissions and Recruitment Centre* entrance in Ontario Street. Instead, go into the *Main Entrance* shown in the photo below, which is 20 meters further on, at **90 London Road**.



The following are the main transport links:

TRAIN

The nearest main-line train stations are **Elephant & Castle** (5 min walk), **Waterloo** (15 min walk) and **London Bridge** (20 min walk). Taxis are available at Waterloo and London Bridge.

TUBE

The nearest tube stations are **Elephant & Castle** (5 min walk), **Southwark** (10 min walk), **Borough** (15 min walk), **Waterloo** (15 min walk) and **London Bridge** (20 min walk).

When you arrive at the Elephant & Castle tube station, use the *South Bank University* exit, not the *Shopping Centre* exit. At street level, turn right and walk down London Road towards St Georges Circus. The Technopark is the first university building on your right. Walk past the *Admissions and Recruitment Centre* entrance on Ontario Street and go into the main entrance, which is 20 meters further on.

CAR

If you are coming by car, you're in for a treat! We're inside London's [Congestion Charge Zone](http://www.cclondon.com/) (see <http://www.cclondon.com/> for details) and you'll need to pay up or else... Street parking is scarce, expensive and vigorously policed. There is a university car park next to the Technopark Building (marked in yellow on the map) but you'll need to contact Biox in advance to arrange access. Its entrance is in **Keyworth Street**, accessed by car via Thomas Doyle Street (one-way, from London Road) or Rotary Street (two-way, from Borough Road).

WHEN YOU GET HERE ...

Announce yourself at the reception desk and ask for Biox.
